



ESF Social Media Press Release re: Eurosurf Junior Games, Morocco

The European Surfing Federation are proud to present the 2016 Eurosurf Junior Surfing Games which will be hosted by the Federation Royale Moracaine de Surf (www.fedesurfmaroc.com) in the vibrant Moroccan coastal city of Agadir from the 3rd to the 11th December 2016. Agadir is a major coastal city situated approximately 500km south of Casablanca at the foot of the famous Atlas Mountains on The Atlantic Ocean. Agadir is also one of Europe's finest surf regions, featuring some of the best waves in the World. The Eurosurf Junior Games, first held in 1992 at the Euskadi beach of Sopelana, will follow on from the 2014 edition of the games held on The Azores, a family of nine Portuguese islands found in the middle of The Atlantic Ocean.

Morocco will be fielding a strong team with the hope of an excellent showing on local ground against the rest of the visiting countries. All together there will be 15 nation teams competing in Agadir with 171 of Europe's strongest U18 surfers taking part.

With the recent results attained by European teams at ISA World Junior Games, it is without question a golden era of junior surfing on the continent and performance levels at the event will undoubtedly highlight the recent upsurge in progression shown by our youngsters.

The event will consist of 196 heats, 68 hours of competition held on twin peaks during the best conditions available with at least 5 full days required to complete the contest.
